Clarification n. 4 and n. 5 - Call for Proposals - Partnering Grants (GP/EFSA/ENCO/2018/03)

We would like to inform you that EFSA has published **clarification n. 4 and 5** in relation to the second call for **Partnering Grants**. We remind you that this initiative focuses on promoting the **transfer or exchange of knowledge and expertise in risk assessment between organisations in different Member States, Norway and Iceland** and, in this way, further **building capacity at EU level**.

The new call will favour (through the award criteria) proposals that a) focus on priorities set under the [EFSA strategy 2020](#) and/or; b) focus on agreed EFSA/MSs priorities (28 in total) as identified in the [Final Report on the identification of food safety priorities using the Delphi technique](#).
