The **Belfast Summit on Global Food Integrity** is taking place from the **28th – 31st May 2018** at the Waterfront Hall, Belfast. The event is being organised by *safefood* in partnership with Queens University Belfast.

'The summit will bring together over 650 delegates from international and governmental agencies, the academic and industrial research community, non-governmental organisations and the commercial & technical leaders in the food industry and all those with a commitment to ensuring the integrity of the world's food supply.

Key themes being explored include:

- Deliberate contamination of food
- The threat from pathogens to the food system



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- Human exposure to chemical cocktails present in foods
- Delivering the nutritional needs for the 21st century global population

Keynote speakers span organisations including PepsiCo, WHO, FAO, WWF, the European Commission and US Homeland Security as well as leading universities, think-tanks and research institutes. Countries represented include Denmark, USA, Austria, China, Czech Republic, Canada, Belgium, Republic of Ireland, UK, Singapore and The Netherlands.
