We would like to inform you that EFSA has launched its second call for **Partnering Grants** and published clarification n. 1.in relation to this grant. We remind you that this initiative focuses on promoting the **transfer or exchange of knowledge and expertise in risk assessment between organisations in different Member States, Norway and Iceland** and, in this way, further **building capacity at EU level**.

The new call will favour (through the award criteria) proposals that a) focus on priorities set under the <u>EFSA strategy 2020</u> and/or; b) focus on agreed EFSA/MSs priorities (28 in total) as identified in the <u>Final</u> <u>Report on the identification of food safety priorities using the Delphi technique</u>.
