# Subject: Request for Proposals to support the development a FAO/WHO guidance on Food Defense

FAO and WHO would like to draw your attention to their joint initiative to develop a guidance on Food Defense. Below is the background information and the link to the expression of interest and request for proposals.

**Background:** The **WHO guidance on Terrorist Threats to Food** was produced in 2002 and slightly updated in 2008 (World Health Organization. (2003). Terrorist threats to food: guidance for establishing and strengthening prevention and response systems. World Health Organization. <u>https://apps.who.int/iris/handle/10665/42619</u>). The WHO initiated an update of the guidance in collaboration with the FAO.

**Outcome:** The new guidance will be jointly developed by WHO and FAO as the **FAO/WHO guidance** on Food Defense

# Ex-ante publicity ECDC call: NP/2020/DPR/13024 Review and evaluation of the public health and animal health aspects of West Nile virus and Usutu virus infection in the European Union | Deadline: 30/11

We want to draw your attention to a call for offer that ECDC will be launching: "Review and evaluation of the public health and animal health aspects of West Nile virus and Usutu virus infection in the European Union". The project aims at reviewing and evaluating the public health and animal health aspects of West Nile virus and Usutu virus infections in the European Union.

The project encompasses i) the organisation of a stakeholder consultation through a questionnaire survey addressed to the public health authorities, the animal health authorities and the blood safety authorities, ii) the organisation of a multi-sectorial meeting (note: the logistics and the logistical costs will be covered by ECDC), and iii) the writing of an integrated technical guidance on West Nile virus and Usutu virus infections in the European Union.

The team conducting this project should be composed of at least the three following profiles: scientific expert from the public health sector, scientific expert from the animal health/veterinary sector and scientific expert from the blood safety sector.

At this stage, we only request that interested candidates express their interest. We do not need to receive any proposal. **Only candidates who have expressed their interest will receive the request for offer and will be able to apply**.

The maximum amount is 60 000 EUR.

Please note that the time limit express interest is 30 November 2020 -16h00 (local time Sweden)

#### EFSA advises on risk assessment of engineered gene drives

EFSA has published a Scientific Opinion on "<u>Adequacy and sufficiency evaluation of existing EFSA</u> guidelines for the molecular characterisation, environmental risk assessment and post-market environmental monitoring of genetically modified insects containing engineered gene drives".

It is accompanied by a news story "<u>EFSA advises on risk assessment of engineered gene drives</u>". It will be available in English, French, German and Italian.

The key messages are:

- EFSA's existing guidelines for the risk assessment of genetically modified animals are adequate for evaluating risks associated with gene drive modified insects. However, further guidance is needed for some areas, such as molecular characterisation, environmental risk assessment and post-market environmental monitoring.
- Current research is looking at deploying engineered gene drives in insect populations, although it will take several years before the use of this technology can be applied in practical, real-life situations.
- To carry out this work, EFSA engaged with stakeholders and scientists at various points in the development of its scientific opinion. A stakeholder workshop in 2019 allowed EFSA to gather views on the subject, and the draft opinion was published for a nine-week public consultation earlier this year.

# Publication of report on comprehensive salt and iodine consumption study in Latvia

The Latvian Institute for Food Safety, Animal Health and Environment "BIOR" would like to share information about recently published report on comprehensive salt and iodine consumption study in Latvia. The purpose of the study was to evaluate salt and iodine intake in Latvian adults aged 19 to 64 by evaluating the nutritional data provided by the participants and the laboratorial analysis of 24-hour urine samples. This study was conducted by Institute for Food Safety, Animal Health and Environment "BIOR" (Riga, Latvia) within the framework of the European Social Fund project "Complex health promotion and disease prevention measures" (ID No. 9.2.4.1/16/I/001). Data collection was conducted between November 2018 and February 2020.
