Public Consultations

Public Consultation on the request for a Scientific opinion on the protection of calves open until 4 November 2022

EFSA's Biological Hazards and Animal Health and Welfare Unit (BIOHAW) launched a public consultation on the assessment relative to the welfare of calves reared for white veal (effects of individual/group housing, and effects of restriction of space, fibre, and iron) and welfare aspects of cow-calf separation.

The draft opinion shared with this public consultation represents part of the final opinion that will address the mandate. The adoption of the scientific opinion is scheduled for March 2023.

EFSA Public consultation: Risk assessment of N-nitrosamines in food | deadline: 22/11/2022

We would like to inform you that EFSA has published for public consultation draft opinion assessing the risks to public health related to the presence of nitrosamines in food.

The assessment concludes that it is highly likely that for all age groups dietary exposure to nitrosamines is above the level that could indicate a health concern. Feedback is particularly welcome on the exposure assessment scenarios used, to reduce uncertainty in the calculation of exposure through the diet.
