Call for Tenders EFSA/2024/OP/0008 - Develop and conduct training courses on Expert Knowledge Elicitation (EKE) | deadline 29.10.2024

Objectives: This call for proposals aims to continue and extend the activity on training EKE methodologies, introducing the current implementation in EFSA's risk assessments, including Behavioural aggregation (e.g., Sheffield), Cooke's, Delphi methods and the Semi-formal protocol.

Budget: maximum € 400,000 for a framework contract of four years.

Deadline for receipt of tenders: 29 October 2024, 14:30 (CET).
