Call for tender on Developing, organizing and delivering of training activities under the EFSA European Food Risk Assessment Fellowship Programme | deadline 22.01.2025

Objective: The objective of the procurement procedure is to identify a contractor which will be responsible for the development, organisation and delivery of training activities under the EFSA European Food Risk Assessment Fellowship Programme, supporting EFSA in the management of the training programme delivered to fellows throughout their participation to the programme.

Budget and duration: The duration of the Framework Contract is of 4 years, and the estimated total value is of €1.6M.

Call for proposals on Selection of hosting sites and fellows for EFSA's European Food Risk Assessment Fellowship (EU-FORA) Programme | deadline 26.02.2025

Objective: The call seeks to identify consortia of hosting sites and fellow sending organisations, both of which must be competent organisations under Article 36 of the Regulation (EC) 178/2002, EFSA's Founding Regulation. The sending organisation will propose a fellow to be trained under a work programme offered by the other consortium partner, who will act as hosting site and will be responsible for the training of the fellow. Hosting sites (consortia leaders) are expected to have a strong capacity and broad experience in one or more activities relevant to food safety risk assessment.

The focus of the EU-FORA fellowship programme will be targeted to activities falling within EFSA's remit.

Budget and duration: The maximum budget EFSA has available is € 825,000 (aiming to conclude 15 Direct Grant Agreements of max. 12 months).

On November 25, 2025, the State General Laboratory of the Republic of Cyprus (SGL) and the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority (NSVFSA) of Romania, with the support of the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), are hosting the online event:

Webinar on call for proposals on surveillance methods for plant pests | 27.11.2025

The European Food Safety Authority (EFSA) will hold a webinar to promote its new call for tender on "Supporting the EU Member States with surveys of Union quarantine pests, Protected zone pests, and pests for which emergency measures are in place" (Ref. EFSA/2025/OP/0026).

Objectives: The webinar aims to provide potential applicants and stakeholders with a clear understanding of the call's objectives, structure, and submission process. Participants will have the opportunity to learn more about the three Lots:

- Lot 1: Development and application of trapping methods for detecting insect pests
- Lot 2: Use of eDNA analyses to support early detection and surveillance of pests
- Lot 3: Application of remote sensing technologies to identify target populations of host plants and support pest detection

Participants: The webinar is intended for all interested stakeholders with expertise in the areas of environmental monitoring, pest trapping, molecular diagnostics, remote sensing, imagery technologies and related scientific fields.

Call for nominations to attend an EFSA Training on TKPlate | deadline 25.11.2025

With this call for nominations, EFSA wishes to draw a list of toxicologists, pharmacokinetic modelers and statistical experts working as risk assessors in Member State and pre-accession countries competent authorities.

Experts with the following expertise will be considered:

- Quantitative toxicology, with emphasis on knowledge related to New Approach methodologies, toxicokinetic and toxicodynamic modelling, dose-response modelling or quantitative analysis of in-vivo and in vitro toxicological studies;
- Statistics in general, with emphasis on those that are dealing with in-vivo, in vitro and in silico toxicological assessments;
- Fluency in English is a requirement.

One expert per Member State and pre-accession countries will be accepted.

Derivation of a health-based guidance value for $\Delta 8$ -tetrahydro-cannabinol ($\Delta 8$ -THC) and its occurrence in food

The European Food Safety Authority (EFSA) was asked to deliver a scientific opinion on the derivation of a health-based guidance value (HBGV) for $\Delta 8$ -tetrahydrocannabinol ($\Delta 8$ -THC) in

food with an assessment of the occurrence of $\Delta 8$ -THC and the co-occurrence with $\Delta 9$ -THC in hemp and hemp-derived products.

Considering the similarity in the effects and modes of action between delta-8 THC and delta-9 THC, EFSA scientists established that both chemicals have similar potency. They concluded that the acute reference dose (ARfD) set in 2015 for delta-9 THC should apply to the total amount of delta-8 THC and delta-9 THC consumed together. The ARfD is 1 microgram (1 millionth of a gram) per kilogram of body weight per day.

Based on EFSA's work, the European Commission and Member States will consider if regulatory measures are needed for delta-8 THC in food to protect consumers from potential health risks.
