Call for Proposals EUBA-EFSA-2024-ENREL-01 on Selection of hosting sites and fellows for EFSA's European Food Risk Assessment Fellowship (EU-FORA) Programme | deadline 20.03.2025

Objectives: The call seeks to identify **consortia of hosting sites and fellow sending organisations**, both of which must be competent organisations under Article 36 of the Regulation (EC) 178/2002, EFSA's Founding Regulation. The sending organisation will propose a fellow to be trained under a work programme offered by the other consortium partner, who will act as hosting site and will be responsible for the training of the fellow. Hosting sites (consortia leaders) are expected to have a strong capacity and broad experience in one or more activities relevant to food safety risk assessment.

Budget: The maximum budget EFSA has available is € 825,000 (aiming to conclude 15 Direct Grant Agreements of max. 12 months).

Public consultations

Call for views on the update of the 2021 EFSA Nano guidance documents | deadline 31.01.2025

We are seeking views on the objectives and scope of a new self-task of the EFSA Scientific Committee to update its 2021 Nano Guidance document. The work entails development of a single <u>Guidance document for risk assessment of nanomaterials and materials containing nanoparticles in the food chain</u>, and a new <u>Guidance document for the risk assessment of feed additives containing nanoparticles</u> produced by EFSA's FEEDAP Panel.

The current consultation (on the two mandates available at the above links) is intended to gather views on the objectives and scope and provide feedback on the main technical and scientific issues, which require harmonisation with regards to nanomaterials and materials containing nanoparticles.

We are **seeking the views of stakeholders and partner organisations** involved in food/feed sector and related areas and/or with the responsibility for food/feed safety and public health. This includes food and feed manufacturers, material and ingredient suppliers, contract laboratories, industry associations, either involved in the production/marketing of particulate materials as micronized materials or engineered nanomaterials, the scientific community, and relevant EU and international regulatory agencies and other relevant bodies.

The input received will be considered by EFSA in the development of the guidance documents and made publicly available as supporting information once finalised.
